Login Process

These instructions are for new members, or not-so-new members who have not yet logged in to the system.

Your user name has been emailed to you, to the address the club holds for you.

If you have not received an email about this, you should contact me at the usual Bookings address.

There is no online registration process. The only way for anyone to be added as a member is for me to create their user entry. For new members this involves sending me an application form with all the usual contact details. When I have created the user entry I will send an email with the user name, and some instructions, which are remarkably similar to these!

For existing members I have already created your user entry, and you should have had an email.

Create your Password

I haven't told you your password so the first time you try to login you will need to create one.

If you've found this doc from the website you've already been here, but if not -

Before you do anything else, write down the password, being very careful to check whether each letter is upper or lower case and being careful with zero and o, and 1 and I.

Better still (as you are going to have to enter this at least twice), 'copy' it by highlighting it with the mouse, right-click and select 'copy'. Then when you need to enter it click the mouse into the password entry box then right-click and 'paste'.

YOU MUST now click on the link to activate the new password.
